AGREEMENT OF SUSPENSION OF LICENCE

1. Greg Sim, of Regina, Saskatchewan was on the register and was a member of the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics (“SCOP”) at the time a complaint was filed regarding his practice as a Paramedic on or about June 27, 2009.

2. As a result of the complaint being filed with the SCOP, an investigation has been launched to inquire into the professional conduct of Greg Sim with a particular emphasis on events surrounding diversion of drugs from [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED] Health Centre.

3. The purpose of the investigation into this matter is to provide evidence and information to the Professional Conduct Committee (“PCC”), to make a report to the Discipline Committee as to whether a Disciplinary Hearing is warranted, or whether a Consensual Complaint Resolution Agreement (“CCRA”) can resolve the matter.

4. In light of the above and in order to avert a court application pursuant to section 28(1) of *The Paramedics Act*, the parties agree as follows:

- a) that Greg Sim is forthwith suspended from the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics;
- b) that Greg Sim shall remain suspended until the PCC completes its investigation and any discipline process is concluded; and
- c) the suspension shall be recorded on the register of the SCOP, and circulated in accordance with standard SCOP policy.

5. The SCOP agrees to revisit the terms of the licence suspension after the investigation by the PCC has been completed, and in any event, no later than 30 days from the signing of this Agreement of Suspension of Licence.

6. The Professional Conduct Committee and the Registrar of the SCOP shall have access to the Agreement of Suspension of Licence. The Registrar of the SCOP shall receive a signed copy of the Agreement of Suspension of Licence and, during the term of the Agreement, the existence of the suspension shall be recorded on the register.

7. Upon inquiry from another jurisdiction, the SCOP shall advise that jurisdiction of the suspension and the outstanding investigation.

8. During the existence of the Agreement of Suspension of Licence, Greg Sim shall refrain from being employed as a paramedic or seeking employ as a paramedic in any jurisdiction.


