

Approved exceptions to full labour mobility.

Applicants from the provinces indicated for each licence level will receive a Restricted Licence prohibiting practice in the identified areas until they have successfully completed the required training modules. When evidence of training completion is provided to the College, a full licence will be issued. There is no fee for the Restricted Licence in this situation.
