Resolution 1:  
Generic Licence  
Level  
Descriptions  
(Housekeeping)

**TITLE of RESOLUTION: Generic Licence Level descriptions (Housekeeping)**

- WHEREAS:** Section 15 of the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics Administrative Bylaws describes the Election of Council; and
- WHEREAS:** Section 15.1.4 describes eligible members using specific nomenclature; and
- WHEREAS:** The nomenclature used in Section 15 is outdated and limiting;
- BE IT RESOLVED:** That Section 15 of the Administrative Bylaws be amended to reflect a generic description of eligible members as follows:
- 15.1.4 three members-at-large nominated from the members registered with the College at any licence level.

## Section 15 (current Language): Saskatchewan College of Paramedics Administrative Bylaws

### 15. Election of Council

- 15.1 For the purposes of clause 8(2)(a) of the Act, the total number of practicing and non-practicing members to be elected to comprise the council is six, including:
- 15.1.1 the president;
  - 15.1.2 the vice-president; and
  - 15.1.3 one member-at-large nominated from the members employed within the fire-fighting sector; and
  - 15.1.4 three members-at-large nominated from the members registered as EMRs, EMTs, EMT-As and EMT-Ps;

**BE IT RESOLVED:** That Section 21(6) of the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics Administrative Bylaws be amended as follows:

21.6 A resolution to amend bylaws may be proposed by a member in good standing to the annual meeting **for consideration and vote at the next annual meeting or at a special meeting called by Council.**

## 2023 AGM Proposed Regulatory Bylaw



### **TITLE of RESOLUTION: Mandatory Professional Liability Insurance**

**WHEREAS:** Section 15(2) of *The Paramedics Act* provides for Regulatory Bylaw making provisions pursuant to section 14; and

**WHEREAS:** Section 15(2)(q) permits the creation of a regulatory bylaw prescribing the minimum amount of liability protection that members are required to obtain;

**BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics - Regulatory Bylaws be amended as follows:

#### **Registration**

##### **Addition of Section 2(1)(f)**

Provide evidence of personal professional liability insurance in accordance with College policy.

#### **Licensure**

##### **Addition of Section 4(1)(d)(4)**

Provide evidence of personal professional liability insurance in accordance with College policy.
