### **Job Description:**

La Ronge Emergency Medical Services (EMS) is a privately run, Indigenous family owned and operated Paramedic Service that has been proudly serving Northern Saskatchewan since 1994. Stationed on Treaty 6 Territory and nestled in the boreal forest and on the shores of Lac La Ronge, La Ronge EMS is a unionized service with Health Sciences Association of Saskatchewan (HSAS) that employs approximately 35 Paramedics.

La Ronge EMS is one of the busiest rural Paramedic Services in Saskatchewan by both geographic area and call volume. Ground Ambulance Services and Air Medevac Services take La Ronge EMS throughout the majority of Northern Saskatchewan as well as into some parts of Manitoba and Alberta, responding to over 500 emergency and non-emergency calls and 125 Air Medevacs a month, averaging over 7500 calls per year.

La Ronge EMS & Northern Air Medevac Service is currently looking for Permanent Part-time (PPT) –Primary Care Paramedics (PCPs), and Advanced Care Paramedics (ACPs) to join our EMS team.

La Ronge EMS provides great benefits for all staff along with a Northern living allowance, yearly northern retention bonus of \$1900.00 on each anniversary date and a pension plan (RRSP). Part-time position (PPT) consists of mostly on call shifts with scheduled Day and Night shifts to cover Holidays, STAT days. Part-time Staff average 3/4 full-time hours and yearly income of \$75,000 to \$95,000. LREMS follows the HSAS pay scale, \$5.00 an hour on call including shift difference and weekend premiums along with a Medevac Bonus of \$60.00 per flight plus much more.
